Public Hearing Waiver of Conflict of Interest for Council Member

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the West Yellowstone Town Council will conduct a public hearing as part of a Special Town Council meeting at **7 PM on Friday, October 13, 2017** in the Town Hall at 440 Yellowstone Avenue, West Yellowstone, Montana. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on the proposal to grant a waiver of the conflict of interest for a council member to have an interest in a contract with the Town, as provided in Section 7-5-4109 Montana Code Annotated. Greg Forsythe, a member of the Town Council and CEO of the Westmart Building Center, Inc., has a financial interest in Westmart's proposal for the construction and sale of a building for the Siegel Learning Center (Little Rangers) for the Town of West Yellowstone. The public hearing will be held to disclose Greg Forsythe's interest in the project and gather public input on whether the waiver should be granted by the Town Council.

All interested persons will have an opportunity to express their opinions regarding the conflict of interest as it relates to the project.
